



These questions will help you in determining if there are conditions on your property that will continue to contribute to rodent activity.

Is pet food or water stored outside?

Is there dog or animal waste on the ground?

Is wood or other materials stored on the ground?

Are there holes larger than ½ inch leading into sheds, garages, basements, or the home?

Are there birdfeeders on the property?
Is seed falling to the ground?

Is there grass/weeds over 6 inches tall?

Is there compost on the property?
Is it stored in an open container or in a pile on the ground?

Is there a pond or container storing water on the property?

Please address any questions in which you answered “yes” to immediately, so that rodent treatment will be successful.

Do your part by: cleaning the yard and removing any bulk items, by not feeding pets outside, and using durable garbage cans with tight-fitting lids.

Is there a vegetable garden on the property?
Are fruits & vegetables falling on the ground?
