Early voting will run seven days a week from **March 17 through March 31, 2025**, in advance of the April 1 election.

MON - SAT: 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
SUN: 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

A government-issued photo ID is not required but is helpful to verify a voter's registration, address or signature. You can vote and register to vote at all Cook County Early Voting Sites. Any voter who needs to register for the first time or file an address change must present two forms of ID, one of which shows the voter's current address.
