To report rodent sightings, contact the Department of Building and Inspectional Services at 847-470-5214. Provide your name, an address where sightings occurred, a phone number, and a description of your concern. The Village's

Rodent Control Program includes inspection, treatment of burrows, and ensuring preventative measures are in place. Treatment involves baiting with rodenticide in a secure manner for residential properties. The Village provides a helpful guide for residents: *Preventing Rodents on Your Property*.
